Subject: Avoidance of mutually conflicting stands by various Government Departments/Corporations/Boards/other authorities in legal matters.


Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to intimate that it has been observed that sometimes a number of Govt. Departments or Other Agencies like Corporations/Boards/Authorities, are arrayed as respondent in Court Cases pending before Hon'ble Supreme Court, Hon'ble High Court or different tribunals. These Government Departments/Agencies sometimes may file replies which are either conflicting in nature or are not consistent with each other. This may create an unnecessarily embarrassing situation for the Government.


In order to deal with such situations, it has been decided that the senior most officer from amongst the respondents will take the lead to identify a Nodal Department/ Agency from amongst the respondents, which will monitor the filing of replies and will also ensure that the replies filed by various Government Agencies/Departments are not conflicting and are consistent with each other.
