Subject:- Regarding communications are being addressed by Govt. Servants directly to the Prime Minister/Prime Minister's Office, Chief Minister of the State Governments etc.

....

In reference to the above stated subject, a D.O. Letter dated 17.8.2015 has been received from the Cabinet Secretary, Govt. of India to the Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana whereby it was pointed out that the practice of the Govt. Servants directly making correspondence in the name of the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Worthy President of India and the other higher constitutional authorities is being adopted by the Govt. Servants which prima facie contravenes the Government Employees (Conduct) Rules, 1966 and such practice should be stopped immediately.

Accordingly the office of Principal Secretary to Govt. Haryana, Monitoring and Co-ordination Cell, Haryana intimated to this office that such type of practice should be stopped immediately and the factum of the D.O. No. 501/1/4/2014-CA.V. be brought to the notice of all concerned employees.

In view of the above stated subject, it is directed that in future no Govt. employees should directly make any correspondence with the higher constitutional dignitaries pertaining to the grievances of Govt. Employees. The representations/appeals if any to be filed to the higher authorities which are maintainable before the Constitutional dignitary, should be routed through their higher authorities in a proper channel. Any lapse of any of the Govt. servant in this respect, shall be viewed seriously which may also deserve to be proceeded departmentally for contravening the Government Employees (Conduct) Rules, 1966. This order be brought to the notice of all the employees of this office.
