APPLICATION UNDER SECTION 151 OF CODE OF  
CIVIL PROCEDURE FOR PLACING ON RECORD  
REVISED GIST OF CLAIMS OF LOSS INCURRED  
DURING AGITATION/RIOTS AFTER THE CONVICTION  
OF DERA SACHA SAUDA CHIEF

**RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH:**

1. That the above mentioned case is pending adjudication before this Hon'ble Court on 17.01.2018.
2. That vide order dated 26.08.2017, this Hon'ble Court passed the following directions:

*"The Deputy Commissioners in the States of Haryana and Punjab shall invite applications/ claims regarding damages caused to public and private properties which shall be verified and forwarded to this Court through the offices of Advocate Generals, Punjab and Haryana."*

3. That thereafter, on 08.11.2017, the State of Haryana submitted the gist of claims received by them from different persons/ authorities/ departments/ agencies, in this Hon'ble Court and this Hon'ble Court passed the following order:

*"(5) The States of Punjab and Haryana have submitted the gist of claims received by them from different persons/ authorities/ departments/ agencies. It is stated by Ld. Advocate General of both the States that no further claim is likely to be received now. They further state that the States of Punjab & Haryana agree in principal for constitution of Tribunal(s) for the quantification of the losses suffered by the claimants....."*

4. That the applicant most respectfully submits that after the passing of the order dated 08.11.2017 the office of Advocate General Haryana received three more claims. Out of these three claims, two were sent by the Deputy Commissioner Rohtak, which were received in the office of the Advocate General, Haryana on 13.11.2017. One claim was sent by National Highway Authority of India, which was received in the office of the Advocate General Haryana on 28.11.2017.

5. That due to the above mentioned reason a Revised Gist of claims of loss incurred during agitation/riots after the conviction of Dera Sacha Sauda Chief has been prepared and is appended with this application as ANNEXURE R-1.

In view of the above, it is most respectfully submitted that the present application be allowed and the Revised Gist of claims of loss incurred during agitation/ riots after the conviction of Dera

Sacha Sauda Chief may kindly be taken on record, in the interest of justice.



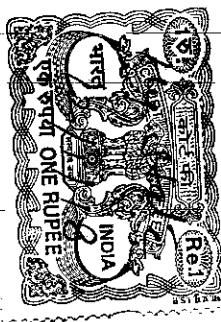
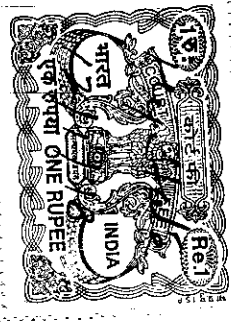
